NOTABLE FIRES.

June 10, at Nos. 43 and 45 White street, a six-story granite building, 50 x 75 feet, occupied by a manufacturer of linens.

The fire originated on the sixth floor and extended to the fifth floor through elevator shaft,

considerably damaging the building.

The first alarm was received at 10.09 v. st., and at 10.13 and 10.30 E. M., respectively, second and third alarms were sent out.

The services of 10 engine and 5 hook and ladder companies were required, and the fire was under control in about one hour and fifty minutes.

Cause of fire, defective electric wiring. Estimated loss, \$105,000.

June 29, at Nes. 19 and 21 Cliff street, a five-story brick building, 50 x 120 feet, occupied by

manufacturer of clocks.

The fire originated in the store-room on fourth floor and extended to the fifth floor, considerably damaging the building.

The first alarm was received at 6.05 A. M., and at 6.15 and 6.19, respectively, second and

The services of 12 engine and 4 hook and ladder composites were required, and the fire was under control in about two hours and eight minutes.

Cause of fire, spontaneous combustion. Estimated loss, \$67,500.
