**REACTIONS FROM HOMELESS SERVICES, REAL ESTATE AND BUSINESS  
COMMUNITY LEADERS TO MAYOR DE BLASIO'S UNVEILING OF HOME-STAT**

"The NYPD's Compstat model is an innovative, problem solving tool that police agencies have implemented across the nation, so it makes perfect sense that HOME-STAT will leverage those same problem solving strategies to address street homelessness outreach efforts," said **John H. Banks, III, President of The Real Estate Board of New York.**
