Incident Summary

NYC Emergency Management continues to coordinate with our partners at the City, State, and Federal levels as well as the private sector in response to COVID-19. There are no specific vaccines or treatments available for this novel coronavirus, or any other coronavirus. However, medication and vaccine research continues.

Tuesday, November 3 is election day. In preparation for potential civil unrest, NYCEM is maintaining situational awareness in collaboration with the New York City Police Department and other agencies. Strategic Partnerships will share alerts as needed, and business owners are encouraged to register for NotifyNYC for the most up to date information.
