Incident Summary

NYC Emergency Management continues to coordinate with our partners at the City, State, and Federal levels as well as the private sector in response to COVID-19. There are no specific vaccines or treatments available for this novel coronavirus, or any other coronavirus. However, medication and vaccine research continues.

Tuesday, November 3 is election day. In preparation for potential civil unrest, NYCEM is maintaining situational awareness in collaboration with the New York City Police Department and other agencies.
