TRANSCRIPT: MAYOR ERIC ADAMS HOSTS AND DELIVERS REMARKS AT MID-AUTUMN MOON FESTIVAL CELEBRATION

Mayor Eric Adams: Thank you. Thank you. Good to see you all here as we celebrate the Moon Festival. And to my colleagues in government: Linda Lee, City Council member; Sandra Ung, City Council member; Marjorie Velázquez, City Council member. And many of our other partners: Commissioner Kim; Harvey Epstein, Assembly member; Jennifer Rajkumar — where's Jennifer? Good to see you, Jennifer. Jennifer Rajkumar, our assemblywoman. We've been around each other through many battles and many struggles.

Now it's our time to make this city a city that appreciates our diversity and everything that we have to offer. And so just as this festival is a family way of coming together to give thanks to the new harvest, let it be a symbol to give thanks to the new harvest of our spirit. COVID has decimated your community, your businesses, has decimated... Two and a half years, our children were not in school. We lost many loved ones. It has really made a major impact on our city and on your community. Well, this is the new harvest. This is our Moon Festival. This is our new awakening. This is our celebration. And so together as we sit here in the people's house, Gracie Mansion, I want to say thank you on behalf of all New Yorkers. And I want say thank you for celebrating the Moon Festival here.
