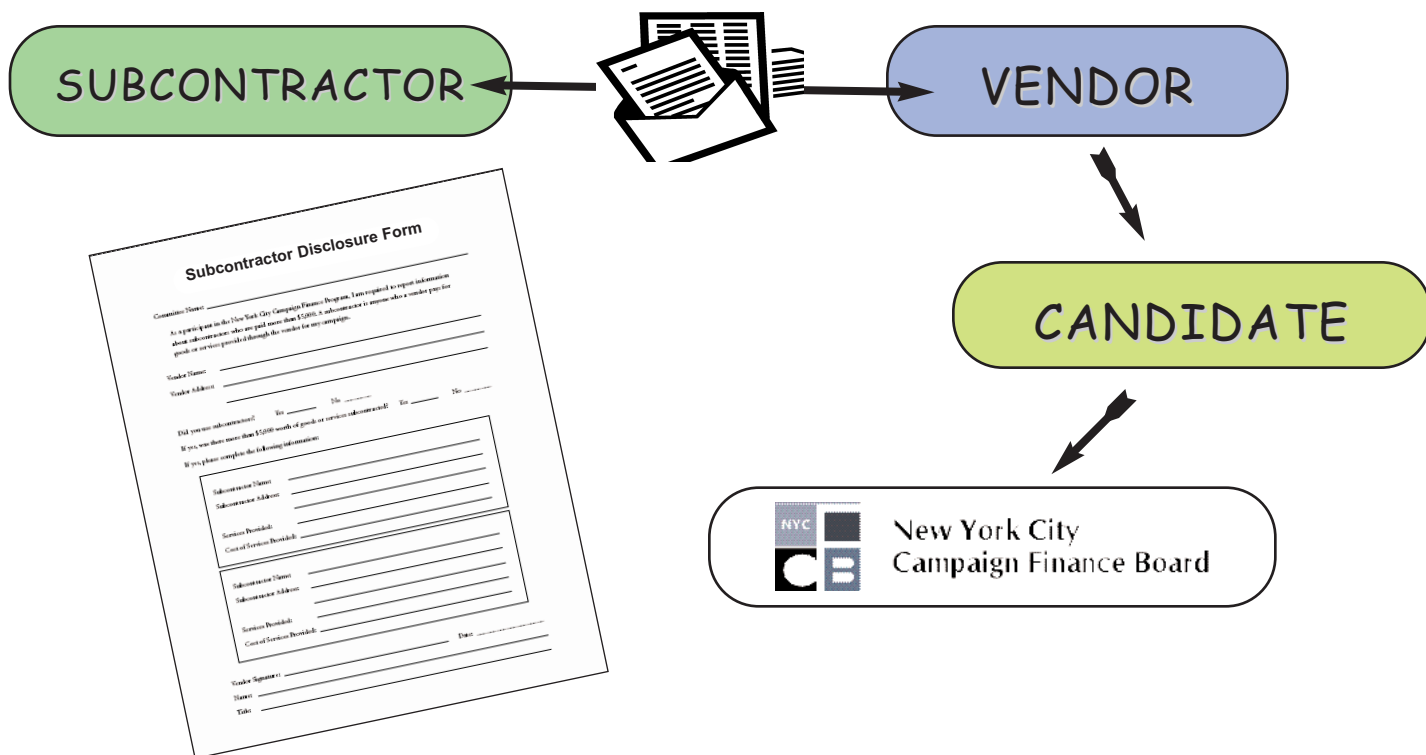


As the 2005 Citywide Election Approaches... Vendors Can Help Candidates Comply With the Campaign Finance Program!



As a vendor, you can help candidates comply with the New York City Campaign Finance Board's (the "CFB") rules by disclosing any subcontractors that you may have used while working for a candidate in our program. If goods or services provided by your subcontractor exceed \$5,000, it needs to be reported to the campaign.

Enclosed are two subcontractor disclosure forms. The first is a sample that shows you how the form should look when filled out correctly. The second form can be reproduced and used by your organization. By filling it out and sending it to your candidate's committee, you will be helping your candidate to comply with our program, as well as disclosing valuable information to the general public.

The Campaign Finance Program helps level the playing field for candidates for the offices of Mayor, Comptroller, Public Advocate, Borough President, or City Council by enforcing expenditure limits and strict disclosure requirements, in return for public matching funds at a rate of \$4-to-\$1. Candidates participating in the Program must comply with the Board's rules, or risk civil penalties or a reduction in public funds payments.
