Some staff return to work the next day, others are out for a number of days.

<sup>3</sup>Both Uniform and Non-Uniform staff who are out sick as a result of COVID-like symptoms must report their absence to the Department's Health Management Division. The data represented in these columns is self reported. The Department continues to encourage all staff experiencing COVID-like symptoms to stay home and seek medical attention.
