#### **COVID-19 Alert Level - LOW**

#### **Get Vaccinated, Get Boosted**

Vaccines are a critical tool in protecting you and your community from severe COVID-19 illness, hospitalization and death. They are proven safe and are now protecting millions of vaccinated New Yorkers from COVID-19.

Vaccine booster shots are now available for all fully vaccinated people 12 and older. These shots boost your immunity from an initial vaccination series.

Separate from booster shots, people ages 5 and older who are moderately to severely immunocompromised (meaning they have a weakened immune system) should get a third dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, as part of their initial vaccination series.

## **Treatment for COVID-19**

If you test positive for COVID-19, getting treatment right away can lessen your symptoms and help you recover sooner. Multiple COVID-19 treatments are now available for people ages 12 and older and can be delivered to your home for free.
