

# WEEKLY INCIDENT BRIEF - COVID-19

## 01/04/2021 – 01/11/2

### Incident Summary

NYC Emergency Management continues to coordinate with our partners at the City, State, and Federal levels as well as the private sector in response to COVID-19. New York State received an initial delivery of 170,000 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine developed by Pfizer. Distribution began in December to front line healthcare workers.
