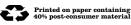

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A REAL PROPERTY ACQUISITIONS AND DISPOSITIONS PUBLIC HEARING, in accordance with Section 824 of the New York City Charter, will be held at 10:00 A.M. on

September 7, 2011 in the 2nd floor conference room, 22 Reade Street, in Manhattan.

IN THE MATTER of a proposed lease for the City of New York, as Tenant, of approximately 10,000 square feet of land and 35,210 rentable square feet of space in the entire one story building located at 22 North 15th Street (Block 2613, Lot 1) in the Borough of Brooklyn, for the Department of Environmental Protection for use as a garage.

The proposed lease shall be for a period of one (1) year and one (1) month, commencing October 1, 2011 and expiring October 31, 2012, at an annual base rent of \$600,000.00 (\$6.00 per square foot for the land, and \$15.34 per square foot for the building).

Within ninety (90) days of lease execution, Tenant shall pay Landlord a negotiated lump sum representing the difference between the "Tenant Not a Holdover" now being paid and the agreed new rent of \$50,000.00 per month for the period from December 23, 2010, the date Landlord took title to the property, until the October 1, 2011 commencement date.

Tenant shall have no right to renew the lease.

IN THE MATTER of a proposed lease renewal for the City of New York, as Tenant, of approximately 5,337 rentable square feet of space on the ground floor in a building located at 410 East 189th Street (Block 3032, Lot 33) in the Borough of The Bronx for the New York Police Department to use as an office.

The proposed renewal of the lease shall be for the term of 2 years from June 6, 2011, at an annual rent of \$120,082.50 (\$22.50 per square foot), payable in equal monthly installments at the end of each month. There will be no rent charged for the 2nd floor storage space.

The lease may be terminated by the Tenant at the end of three (3) years, or at any time thereafter, provided the Tenant gives the Landlord sixty (60) days prior written notice. In the event that the lease is terminated by the Tenant, the Tenant shall pay to the Landlord the unamortized portion of the Tenant's brokerage commission.

Procurement notices in the CR are arranged by alphabetically listed Agencies, and within Agency, by Division if any. The notices for each Agency (or Division) are further divided into three subsections: Solicitations, Awards; and Lists & Miscellaneous notices. Each of these subsections separately lists notices pertaining to Goods, Services, or Construction.

Notices of Public Hearings on Contract Awards appear at the end of the Procurement Section.

At the end of each Agency (or Division) listing is a paragraph giving the specific address to contact to secure, examine and/or to submit bid or proposal documents, forms, plans, specifications, and other information, as well as where bids will be publicly opened and read. This address should be used for the purpose specified unless a different one is given in the individual notice. In that event, the directions in the individual notice should be followed.

The following is a SAMPLE notice and an explanation of the notice format used by the CR.
