Pursuant to Section 3-11 of the PPB Rules, The New York City Police Department ("NYPD") is seeking to enter into a contract for a Demonstration Project with ShotSpotter, Inc. (DBA SST, Inc.), 7979 Gateway Blvd., Newark, CA 94560, for a Gunshot Detection and Location System (the "System"). The NYPD is seeking to enter into a contract for the implementation of the System as a 2-Year Demonstration Project covering up to 15 Square miles of New York City. The proposed System would use specially placed microphones to pinpoint, in seconds, the precise location of gunfire within the coverage areas. The System will also include an adjudication capability in which analysts will listen to each recorded alert and screen out false positives (such as fireworks). The purpose of the System is to both detect and to deter gunfire activity, including drug-related and "celebratory" gunfire that may terrorize communities or end in tragic deaths.

ShotSpotter, has developed a gunshot detection and location system that utilizes an entirely different technological, adjudicatory, and financial model from other such systems that have been tried unsuccessfully in the past by the NYPD. ShotSpotter uses a network of sensors (15-20 per square mile) that are affixed to rooftops and other high points. The system uses triangulation to determine the exact location from which a shot was fired. ShotSpotter also employs a team of analysts, stationed at a round-the-clock adjudication center, to listen to the sounds that prompted each alert. Adding human judgment to the process should drastically reduce the number of false positives. The Department is not aware of any other vendor which offers a gunshot detection system utilizing a technological and adjudicatory approach similar to that of ShotSpotter, Inc,.

The Demonstration period will be used to evaluate the effectiveness of such a system within the environment of New York City. If the System proves to be a success, then the NYPD currently plans to do a

competitive solicitation for the implementation of a Gunshot Detection and Location System over a larger coverage area.

What authorizes Department of Finance to make this rule? New York City Administrative Code § 11-208.1 and New York City Charter ("Charter") §§ 1043 and 1504 authorize the Department of Finance to make this proposed rule.

Where can I find the Department of Finance's rules? The Department of Finance's rules can be found in Title 19 of the Rules of the City of New York.

What rules govern the rulemaking process? The Department of Finance must meet the requirements of § 1043 of the Charter when creating or amending rules. This notice is made according to the requirements of § 1043 of the Charter.

Statement and Basis and Purpose of Proposed Rule

Section 11-208.1 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York requires that owners of income-producing real property in New York City file income and expense statements each year for the property. The Department of Finance uses the information in the statements to assess the value of real property in the City.

Local Law 52 of 2013 amended Administrative Code § 11-208.1. These proposed amendments will, among other things, conform the rules relating to the filing of income and expense statements set forth in Chapter 33 of Title 19 of the Rules of the City of New York to the Administrative Code by:

- revising the deadline for filing the annual income and expense statements from September 1 to June 1;
- providing that if a property owner has not owned the property and is without knowledge of the income and expenses of the property for the entire year for which the income and expense statement is required, then the owner must file a claim of exclusion and will not be required to file an income and expense statement for that year;
- providing penalties for the failure to file a claim of exclusion, where it is required, and the opportunity for property owners to be heard prior to the imposition of such penalties;
- authorizing the Commissioner of Finance to extend the deadline for filing by up to sixty days for income and expense statements or claims of exclusion for residential class two properties held in the cooperative or condominium form of ownership (the existing rules authorize the Commissioner to provide up to thirty days extension for all properties);
- providing that monetary penalties imposed for failure to file an income and expense statement, or, where required, a claim of exclusion, will be liens on the affected real property and will accrue interest until they are paid; and
- providing an "innocent purchaser" waiver mechanism for property owners who took title to real property without knowledge that a monetary penalty would be imposed for the prior owner's failure to timely file.

Matter $\underline{\text{underlined}}$ is new. Matter in brackets [] is to be deleted.

"Will" and "must" denote mandatory requirements and may be used interchangeably in the rules of this department unless otherwise specified or unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Amendments to Rules Relating to the Filing of Income and Expense Statements

- §1. Paragraph (2)(i) of subdivision (b) of chapter 33-01 of title 19 of the Rules of the City of New York (Rules Relating to the Filing of Income and Expense Statements) is amended to read as follows:
 - (i) property with a [final] tentative actual assessed valuation of \$40,000 or less[;] on the tentative assessment roll promulgated in the year that the income and expense statement would otherwise be required to be filed pursuant to subdivision (a) of section 33-02 of these rules; notwithstanding the preceding sentence, owners are not required to file income and expense statements if the actual assessed valuation for such tax year is subsequently reduced to \$40,000 or less;
- §2. Subdivision (a) of section 33-02 of such rules is amended to read as follows:

- (a) Deadlines.
 - (1) Owners of income-producing property must file with the Department of Finance an income and expense statement no later than the first day of [September] June of each year. If the first day of June falls on a Saturday, Sunday or City of New York holiday, the deadline for filing will be the next business day. A separate income and expense statement must be filed for each parcel of income-producing property, except that a consolidated income and expense statement may be filed for one or more tax lots that are:
 - (i) operated together as an economic unit or are otherwise related for purposes of valuation; and
 - (ii) are under common ownership; and
 - (iii) are contiguous or within the same tax block or within adjacent tax blocks; and
 - (iv) are located within the same borough of the City.
 - (2) The Commissioner of Finance may for good cause extend the deadline contained in paragraph (1) of this subdivision (a) for filing an income and expense statement by a period not to exceed thirty days, except that with respect to residential class two properties held in the cooperative or condominium form of ownership, by a period not to exceed sixty days.
- §3. Paragraphs (1) and (2) of subdivision (b) of section 33-02 of such rules are amended to read as follows:
 - (1) Income and expense statements <u>or</u>, <u>where required</u>, <u>claims of exclusion</u> must be submitted electronically in the format prepared by the Department of Finance and located on the Department of Finance Internet website and in accordance with the instructions for submission of the income and expense statement found on the website.
 - (2) Request for waiver of electronic filing requirement. The Commissioner may, for good cause, waive the requirement that the income and expense statement or, where required, claim of exclusion be filed electronically and permit the income and expense statement or, where required, claim of exclusion to be filed by means of a paper form. A request for waiver of the electronic filing requirement must be made in writing no later than thirty days prior to the deadline for filing an income and expense statement or, where required, claim of exclusion. Any filing in paper format must be filed with the New York City Department of Finance at such address as may be designated by the Department.
- $\S4$. Paragraphs (2), (4) and (5) of subdivision (c) of section 33-02 of such rules are amended to read as follows:
 - (2) Owners of income-producing property who maintain their books and records on a fiscal year basis must file an income and expense statement containing information for the last fiscal year concluding before the first day of [August] <u>May</u> immediately preceding the deadline for filing such statements
 - (4) [Owners of income-producing property who purchase their property within the twelve month period prior to the first day of August immediately preceding the deadline for filing such statements, and who are without knowledge of the income and expenses of the property for the entire year, shall file an income and expense statement containing the date of purchase, the sale price, the name of the grantor(s) and all information reflecting their actual period of ownership.] Where the owner of the property has not owned the property and is without knowledge of the income and expenses of the operation of the property for the entire year for which the income and expense statement is required, then an income and expense statement will not be required for such year. However, the owner may be required to file a claim of exclusion pursuant to paragraph (3) of subdivision (e) of section 33-02 of these rules.
 - (5) In addition to the income and expense statement, for any year, the Commissioner of Finance may require owners of income-producing property with a [final] tentative actual assessed value at or above an amount determined by the Commissioner to file an addendum to the income and expense statement in a format determined by the Commissioner, containing rent roll information for a period determined by the Commissioner. The addendum will not be required for a property with a [final] tentative actual assessed value of less than \$750,000 for the tax year during which filing of the income and expense statement is required. Any addendum required by this paragraph will be considered to be a part of the income and expense statement and any filing requirement contained in these rules for the income and expense statement will also be applicable to the addendum.

- §5. Subparagraphs (i) and (ii) of paragraph (3) of subdivision (e) of section 33-02 of such rules are amended, and new subparagraphs (iv), (v) and (vi) are added to such paragraph (3), to read as follows:
 - (3) (i) Owners of property who contend that they are excluded from the filing requirement based on any provision of paragraph (2) of subdivision (b) of section [8]33-01 of these rules, other than subparagraphs (i), (ii), (iii) or (vii) of such paragraph (2), must file with the Department of Finance a claim of exclusion on a form prepared by the Department, no later than [September 1, 2014 and on or before September 1 in every third year thereafter] the first day of June each year for as long as the owner claims that the property is excluded from the filing requirement. If the first day of June falls on a Saturday, Sunday or City of New York holiday, the deadline for filing will be the next business day.
 - (ii) In addition to the requirements of subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, owners of properties who claim that they are excluded from the filing requirement, and are required to file a claim of exclusion, must file a claim of exclusion on a form prepared by the Department no later than the [September] June 1 that immediately follows the date on which the owner took title to the property. If the first day of June falls on a Saturday, Sunday or City of New York holiday, the deadline for filing will be the next business day.
 - (iv) Owners of property who are required to file a claim of exclusion pursuant to paragraph (3) of subdivision (e) of section 33-02 of these rules who file neither a timely claim of exclusion nor a timely income and expense statement will be subject to the penalties set forth in section 11-208.1 of the Administrative Code and section 33-03 of these rules.
 - (v) The Commissioner may for good cause extend the deadlines provided in subparagraphs (i) and (ii) of this paragraph for filing a claim of exclusion by a period not to exceed thirty days, except that with respect to residential class two properties held in the cooperative or condominium form of ownership, by a period not to exceed sixty days.
 - (vi) Notwithstanding the submission of a claim of exclusion by an owner, for purposes of section 33-03 of these rules, the term "failure to file a claim of exclusion" may include, but not be limited to:
 - (A) failure to file in the electronic format prepared by the Department of Finance, or, in the event that the electronic filing requirement is waived by the Commissioner under paragraph (2) of subdivision (b) of section 33-02 of these rules, failure to use the forms prepared by the Department of Finance;
 - (B) failure to submit a claim of exclusion containing the original signature of the owner or owners, or the signature of an agent accompanied by a power of attorney authorization);
 - (C) failure to submit a separate claim of exclusion for each parcel (consolidated claims of exclusion may be submitted only for contiguous condominium lots operated as a single entity); and
 - (D) failure to complete forms in a legible manner.
- §6. Subdivision (a) of section 33-03 of such rules is amended to read as follows:
- (a) Monetary penalties.
 - (1) Owners of income-producing property who fail to file an income and expense statement by the first day of [September] June, or in the event of an extension, by the extended due date, will be subject to a penalty not to exceed three percent of the final actual assessed valuation for the property for the tax year in which such a statement was required to be filed.
 - (2) Owners of income-producing property who fail to file an income and expense statement by the thirty-first day of December will be subject to a penalty not to exceed four percent of the final actual assessed valuation for the property for the tax year in which such a statement was to be filed.
 - (3) If, in the year immediately following the year in which an owner fails to file an income and expense statement by the thirty-first day of December, the owner again fails to file an income and expense statement within the time provided in subdivision (a) of section [§]33-02 of these rules (determined with regard to any extension of time for filing), such owner will be subject to a penalty in an amount not to exceed five percent of the final actual assessed value of such property determined for the tax year in which such a statement was

to be filed. Such owner will also be subject to a penalty of up to five percent of such final actual assessed value in any year immediately succeeding a year in which a penalty of up to five percent could have been imposed, if in such succeeding year the owner fails to file an income and expense statement within the time prescribed in section [§]33-02(a) of these regulations (determined with regard to any extension of time for filing).

- (4) Owners of income-producing property who are required to submit a claim of exclusion but fail to do so by the first day of June, or in the event of an extension, by the extended due date, will be subject to a penalty. Such penalty will not exceed the following amounts:
 - (i) one hundred dollars for failure to submit a claim of exclusion in one year;
 - (ii) five hundred dollars for failure to submit a claim of exclusion in two consecutive years;
 - (iii) one thousand dollars for failure to submit a claim of exclusion in three consecutive years or more.
- (5) Any penalties prescribed in subdivision (a) of section 33-03 of these rules when entered in the records of the Department of Finance will be a lien on the real property as to which the statement or claim was required to be filed and will continue to be a lien until paid. The lien may be enforced by tax lien sale, in rem foreclosure, or any other means provided by law for enforcement of tax liens.
- (6) If any penalty imposed under this subdivision is not paid within thirty days from the date it is entered in the records of the Department of Finance, interest will accrue on the amount of the penalty at the rate applicable to the affected real property for delinquent real property taxes, calculated from the date of entry to the date of payment.
- (7) Innocent purchasers. In cases where the closing or finalizing of the sale of real property precedes the publication of the lists described in paragraph (4) of subdivision (e) of section 33-02 of these rules or the first property tax bill or Statement of Account to reflect a penalty imposed on such property for failure to file an income and expense statement or, when required, a claim of exclusion, the Commissioner may waive any such penalty and/or cancel the lien imposed as a result of such penalty, upon request of the owner of the property, provided the owner files in the electronic format prepared by the Department a properly completed innocent purchaser waiver request no later than thirty days following the date of the notice described in subparagraphs (i) and (ii) of subdivision (a) of section 33-04 of such rules.
- (8) The Commissioner, may for good cause, waive the requirement that the innocent purchaser waiver request form be filed electronically and permit the innocent purchaser waiver request form to be filed by means of a paper form. A request for waiver of the electronic filing requirement must be made in writing no later than fifteen days following the date of the notice described in subparagraphs (i) and (ii) of subdivision (a) of section 33-04 of these rules, Any filing in paper format must be filed with the New York City Department of Finance at such address as may be designated by the Department.

 $\S 7.$ Subparagraphs (i) and (ii) of paragraph (1) of subdivision (a) of section 33-04 of such rules are amended to read as follows:

- (i) Owners of income-producing property who fail to file a timely income and expense statement or, where required, a claim of exclusion, in compliance with section [§]11-208.1 of the Administrative Code and these rules will be notified of such failure to comply and of the opportunity for a hearing prior to the imposition of the penalties contained in section [§]33-03 of these rules.
- (ii) Except as provided in subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, the notice will also provide that such owners may avoid penalties for failure to file by filing a properly completed income and expense statement or, where required, a claim of exclusion, no later than thirty days following the date of the notice.

§9. Subparagraphs (i) and (ii) of paragraph (7) of subdivision (a) of section 33-04 of such rules are amended to read as follows:

- (7) Matters reviewable. The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether:
 - an income and expense statement <u>or</u>, <u>where required</u>, a <u>claim of exclusion</u>, was not filed, and if it was not filed, what penalties, if any, should be imposed;
 - (ii) an income and expense statement <u>or, where required, a claim of exclusion,</u> was not timely filed, and if it was not

timely filed, what penalties, if any, should be imposed; and/or

- Is understandable and written in plain language for the discrete regulated community or communities;
- Minimizes compliance costs for the discrete regulated community or communities consistent with achieving the stated purpose of the rule; and
- (iii) Provides a cure period of thirty days without penalty for owners to file income and expense statements or, where required, a claim of exclusion.

What are we proposing? The Taxi and Limousine Commission is considering changing its rules regarding the payment of the Taxi Accessibility Fee by taxicab medallion owners. The Taxi Accessibility fee is paid annually by medallion owners in order to provide accessible service to Wheelchair using passengers. The proposed change to the rule would require medallion owners to remit payment of the Taxi Accessibility Fee to the Taxi and Limousine Commission instead of making payment to the Accessible Taxi Dispatcher.

When and where is the Hearing? The Commission will hold a public hearing, at which the public and interested parties are invited to submit comments and testimony on the proposed rules, at 9:00 a.m. on August 7, 2014. This hearing will be held in the Commission's public hearing room at 33 Beaver St., New York, NY on the 19th Floor.

What authorizes the Commission to make this rule? Sections 1043 and 2303 of the City Charter and section 19-503 of the City Administrative Code authorize the Commission to make this proposed rule. This proposed rule was not included in the Commission's regulatory agenda for this Fiscal Year because the need for it was not contemplated when the Commission published the agenda.

Where can I find the Commission's rules? The Commission's rules are in title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York.

What rules govern the rulemaking process? The Commission must meet the requirements of Section 1043 of the City Charter when creating or changing rules. This notice is made according to the requirements of Section 1043(b) of the City Charter.

STATEMENT OF BASIS AND PURPOSE OF RULES

The TLC seeks to change how Medallion Owners pay the Taxi Accessibility Fee required by TLC's Accessible Dispatch Program.

After reviewing the first year of operation of the Accessible Dispatch program, the TLC has decided that the Taxi Accessibility Fee paid by Medallion Owners should be paid directly to the TLC instead of to the Accessible Taxi Dispatcher. Payments to the TLC will be placed in a Trust in Agency account. The TLC believes that direct payments to the TLC will make the new payment process more efficient and easier to monitor. The TLC will amend the current agreement with Metro Taxi, Inc. to reflect this change.

The proposed changes to the rules will not alter the original purpose or intent of the current Accessible Dispatch Program. The change only modifies the process for payment of the Taxi Accessibility Fee by medallion owners. The TLC does not anticipate an adverse impact on medallion owners resulting from the payment of this fee to the TLC.

The Commission's authority for these rules is found in section 2303 of the New York City Charter and Section 19-503 of the New York City Administrative Code.

Section 1. The definition of "Taxi Accessibility Fee" set forth in section 51-03 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§51-03 Definitions

Taxi Accessibility Fee is the fee required by these rules to be paid by Owners, as defined by Chapter 58, to the [Accessible Taxi Dispatcher] Commission to provide accessible service to Wheelchair using Passengers. The Taxi Accessibility Fee shall be set in accordance with the terms of an agreement between the Commission and an approved vendor and will be based on the per medallion cost to the vendor for equipment, administrative expenses associated with operation of the dispatch system, outreach and Dispatch Fees.

Section 2. The definition of "Taxi Accessibility Fee" set forth in section 53-03 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§53-03 Definitions

(b) $Taxi\ Accessibility\ Fee$ is the fee required by these rules to be paid by Owners to the

[Accessible Taxi Dispatcher] <u>Commission</u> to provide accessible service to Wheelchair using Passengers. The Taxi Accessibility Fee shall be set in accordance with the terms of an agreement between the Commission and an approved vendor and will be based on the per medallion cost to the vendor for equipment, administrative expenses associated with operation of the dispatch system, outreach and Dispatch Fees.

Section 3. The definition of "Taxi Accessibility Fee" set forth in section 58-03 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§58-03 Definitions Specific to this Chapter

(a) Taxi Accessibility Fee [as used in this Chapter,] is the fee required by these rules to be paid by Owners to the [Accessible Taxi Dispatcher] Commission to provide accessible service to Wheelchair using Passengers. The Taxi Accessibility Fee shall be set in accordance with the terms of an agreement between the Commission and an approved vendor and will be based on the per medallion cost to the vendor for equipment, administrative expenses associated with operation of the dispatch system, outreach and Dispatch Fees.

Section 4. Subdivision (j) of section 58-07 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(j) Taxi Accessibility Fee. An Owner must pay the Taxi Accessibility Fee [set by the Accessible Taxi Dispatcher] for each Medallion owned. The Taxi Accessibility Fee must be paid when charged by the Commission.

Section 5. Subdivision (f) of section 58-16 of Title 35 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

- (f) Taxi Accessibility Fee.
- (1) An Owner must pay the Taxi Accessibility Fee for each of the Owner's Medallions as required by the [Accessible Taxi Dispatcher] Commission.
- (2) The Owner must pay the Taxi Accessibility Fee when required to do so by the [Accessible Taxi Dispatcher] <u>Commission</u>. If the Taxi Accessibility Fee is not paid by the time required by the [Accessible Taxi Dispatcher] <u>Commission</u>, the Owner will be liable for penalties for non-payment.
- [(3) If an Owner does not pay the Taxi Accessibility Fee by the time required, non-payment will be grounds for suspension or revocation of the Taxicab license, and/or denial of any renewal application or of any application for another TLC issued license, as well as monetary penalties.]
- [(4) An Owner must comply with all requirements of the Accessible Taxi Dispatcher relating to payment of the Taxi Accessibility Fee. An Owner must register with the Accessible Taxi Dispatcher for purposes of billing the Taxi Accessibility Fee and must keep all registration and billing information current.]

READER'S GUIDE

The City Record (CR) is published each business day and includes notices of proposed New York City procurement actions, contract awards, and other procurement-related information. Solicitation notices for most procurements valued at or above \$100,000 for information technology and for construction and construction related services, above \$50,000 for other services, and above \$25,000 for other goods are published for at least one day. Other types of procurements, such as sole source, require notice in Theorem (CR) and the sole source require notice in Theorem (CR). procurements, such as sole source, require notice in The City Record for five consecutive days. Unless otherwise specified, the agencies and offices listed are open for business Monday through Friday from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., except on legal holidays.

NOTICE TO ALL NEW YORK CITY CONTRACTORS

The New York State Constitution ensures that all laborers, workers or mechanics employed by a contractor laborers, workers or mechanics employed by a contractor or subcontractor doing public work are to be paid the same wage rate that prevails in the trade where the public work is being done. Additionally, New York State Labor Law §§ 220 and 230 provide that a contractor or subcontractor doing public work in construction or building service must pay its employees no less than the prevailing wage. Section 6-109 (the Living Wage Law) of the New York City Administrative Code also provides for a "living wage", as well as prevailing wage, to be paid to workers employed by City contractors in certain occupations. The Comptroller of the City of New York is occupations. The Comptroller of the City of New York is mandated to enforce prevailing wage. Contact the NYC Comptroller's Office at www.comptroller.nyc.gov, and click on Prevailing Wage Schedules to view rates.

The City of New York is committed to achieving excellence in the design and construction of its capital program, and building on the tradition of innovation in architecture and engineering that has contributed to the City's prestige as a global destination.

VENDOR ENROLLMENT APPLICATION

New York City procures approximately \$17 billion worth of goods, services, construction and construction-related services every year. The NYC Procurement Policy Board Rules require that agencies primarily solicit from established mailing lists called bidder/proposer lists. Registration for these lists is free of charge. To register for these lists, prospective suppliers should fill out and submit the NYC-FMS Vendor Enrollment application, which can be found online at www.nyc.gov/selltonyc. To request a paper copy of the application, or if you are uncertain whether you have already submitted are uncertain whether you have already submitted an application, call the Vendor Enrollment Center at (212) 857-1680.

SELLING TO GOVERNMENT TRAINING WORKSHOP

New and experienced vendors are encouraged to register for a free training course on how to do business with New York City. PRE-QUALIFIED LISTS

New York City procurement policy permits agencies to develop and solicit from pre-qualified lists of vendors, under prescribed circumstances. When an agency decides to develop a pre-qualified list, criteria for pre-qualification must be clearly explained in the solicitation and notice of the opportunity to pre-qualify for that solicitation must be published in at least five issues of the CR. A completed qualification questionnaire may be submitted to an Agency Chief Contracting Officer at any time, unless otherwise indicated, and action (approval or denial) shall be taken by the agency within 90 days from the date of submission. Any denial or revocation of pre-qualified status can be appealed to the Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings (OATH). Section 3-10 of the Procurement Policy Board Rules describes the criteria for the general use of pre-qualified lists. NON-MAYORAL ENTITIES

The following agencies are not subject to Procurement Policy Board Rules and do not follow all of the above procedures: City University, Department of Education, Metropolitan Transportation Authority, Health & Hospitals Corporation, and the Housing Authority. Suppliers interested in applying for inclusion on bidders lists for Non-Mayoral entities should contact these

entities directly at the addresses given in the Vendor Information Manual.

PUBLIC ACCESS CENTER

The Public Access Center is available to suppliers and the public as a central source for supplier-related information through on-line computer access. The Center is located at 253 Broadway, 9th floor, in lower Manhattan, and is open Monday through Friday from 9:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., except on legal holidays. ATTENTION: NEW YORK CITY MINORITY AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES

Join the growing number of Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprises (M/WBEs) that are competing for New York City's business. In order to become certified for the program, your company must substantiate that it: (1) is at least fifty-one percent (51%) owned, operated and controlled by a minority or woman and (2) is either located in New York City or has a significant tie to New Vork City's business community. PROMPT PAYMENT

It is the policy of the City of New York to pay its bills promptly. The Procurement Policy Board Rules generally require that the City pay its bills within 30 days after the receipt of a proper invoice. The City pays interest on all late invoices. However, there are certain types of payments that are not eligible for interest; these are listed in Section 4-06 of the Procurement Policy Board Rules. The Comptroller and OMB determine the interest rate on late payments twice a year: in January and in

Procurement notices in the CR are arranged by alphabetically listed Agencies, and within Agency, by Division if any. The notices for each Agency (or Division) are further divided into three subsections: Solicitations, Awards; and Lists & Miscellaneous notices. Each of these subsections separately lists notices pertaining to Goods, Services, or Construction.

Notices of Public Hearings on Contract Awards appear at the end of the Procurement Section.

At the end of each Agency (or Division) listing is a paragraph giving the specific address to contact to secure, examine and/or to submit bid or proposal secure, examine and/or to submit but of proposal documents, forms, plans, specifications, and other information, as well as where bids will be publicly opened and read. This address should be used for the purpose specified unless a different one is given in the individual notice. In that event, the directions in the individual notice should be followed.
