

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







Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19 July 24 – July 30, 2021



Number of Currently Incarcerated Patients with Confirmed COVID-19 March 17, 2020 – July 30, 2021











Number and Percent of Open Units Above and Below 50% Capacity by Housing Category July 29, 2021


