

Thanksgiving Day Safety Tips

- Never leave hot food or appliances unattended while cooking.
- Always be alert when you are cooking. If you are under the influence of medication or alcohol, avoid using the stove.
- Keep anything that can catch fire away from stoves, toaster ovens, or other heat sources.
- Use the 3-foot rule - keep children and pets at least 3 feet away from hot surfaces.
- Do not wear loose-fitting clothes when you are cooking.
- If you are frying, grilling, or broiling food, stay in the kitchen.

All Volunteer leadership should be encouraging active members to serve in a mentor role in order to support both their growth as leaders and provide new opportunities for newer members to become more engaged.




Manhattan Division 3 held their monthly meeting earlier this week. District leader Beth Rowan gave a provided




