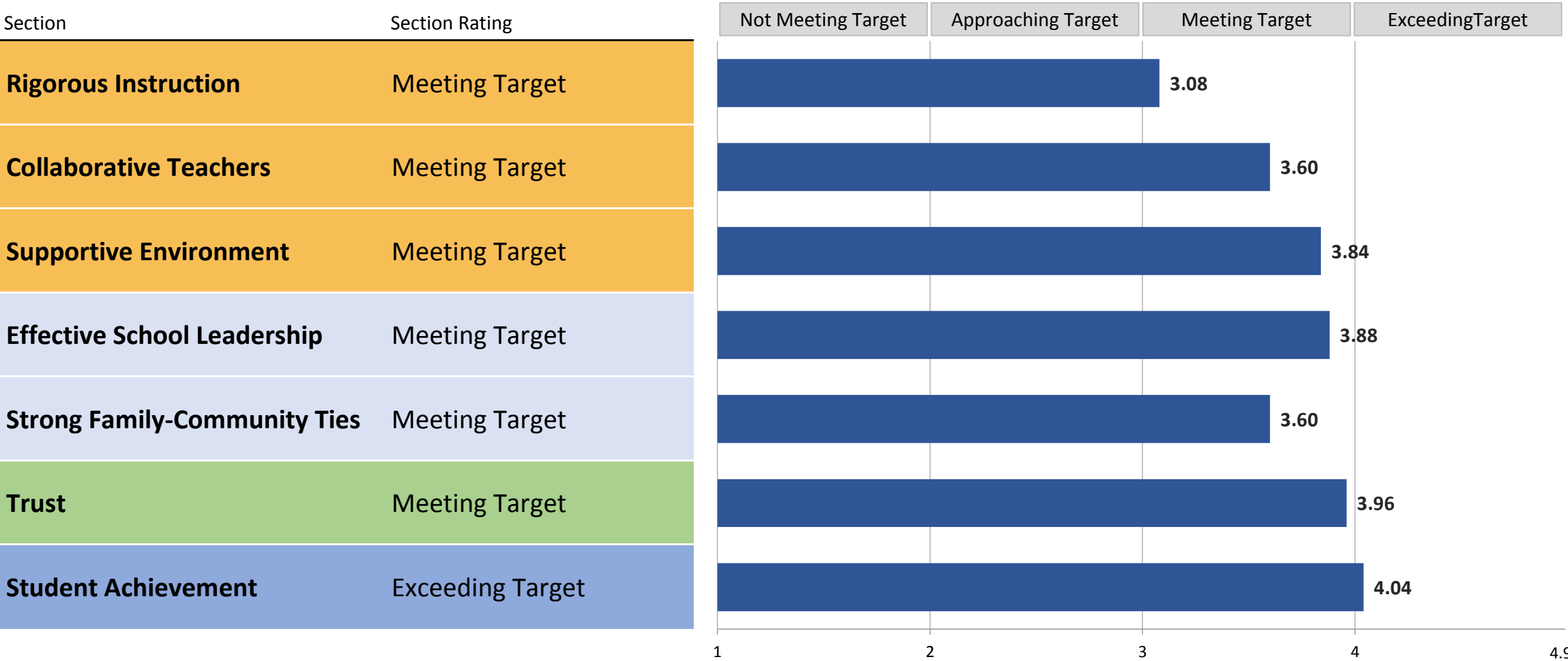
Summary of Section Ratings
