PUBLIC SCHEDULE FOR MAYOR ERIC ADAMS FOR SUNDAY, JANUARY 15, 2023

On Sunday, January 15, New York City Mayor Eric Adams will be in El Paso, Texas, making multiple stops at and near the U.S. southern border as New York City continues to face an unprecedented influx of asylum seekers.

First, the mayor will meet with local officials, including El Paso Mayor Oscar Leeser, to see how the migrant crisis has affected the local community and what processes they are following. This event is closed press.

Then, the mayor will visit a local shelter where asylum seekers have been staying while in El Paso. This event is closed press.

Next, the mayor will visit a facility providing a multitude of support services to asylum seekers. This event is closed press.

After, the mayor will tour a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) processing facility and visit the U.S. southern border. This event is closed press.

Immediately after, the mayor will hold a media availability.

Finally, the mayor will travel back to New York City.
