This notice is being submitted to you pursuant to Title 22 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, Chapter 8, Subchapter 2, §22-822, with respect to the New York City Industrial Development Agency project (the "Project") described below:

Project Description:

- Name of assistance recipient: Soltage Maspeth ESS, LLC is a Delaware limited liability company (the "Company"). The Company is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Soltage NY DevCo, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, and an indirect whollyowned subsidiary of Soltage, LLC ("Soltage"). Soltage is a private, independent power producer that develops solar energy generation facilities and energy storage projects. Soltage's majority owner is Igneo Infrastructure Partners, a global infrastructure investment firm.
- 2. Project location: 53-11 54th Avenue, Maspeth, Queens, New York 11378.
- 3. **Description of the Project:** The Company is seeking financial assistance in connection with the construction and equipping of a battery energy storage system with an estimated storage capacity of 20 Megawatts ("MW"). The battery storage system consists of battery packs, a concrete blockhouse for equipment, including transformers, switchboards, and metering capable of providing 80 MW hours of energy storage capacity total per day. The battery energy storage system will occupy 7,726 square feet and will be located on a 25,696 square foot parcel of land at 53-11 54th Avenue, Maspeth, Queens, New York ("Facility"). The Facility will be owned and operated by the Company as a battery energy storage system capable of charging from and discharging into the New York power grid. Address: 53-11 54th Avenue, Maspeth, Queens, New York 11378.
- 4. Estimated Project budget: \$88,767,300.
- 5. Explanation of how City assistance, funding or benefits will be used: The recipient will receive the following financial assistance in order to induce the recipient to complete the Project and operate the Facility for the intended Project purposes: (i) partial exemption from City and State mortgage recording taxes and (ii) exemption from City and State sales and use taxes.
