EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 29  
MARCH 4, 1996

DESIGNATION OF FIRE DEPARTMENT AS THE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE  
FILING OF CERTIFICATES OF EXPENSES RELATING TO COSTS INCURRED BY  
THE DEPARTMENT IN RESPONDING TO EMERGENCIES INVOLVING THE  
RELEASE OR THREAT OF RELEASE OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES INTO THE  
ENVIRONMENT

By the power vested in me as the Mayor of the City of New York, it hereby is ordered:

Section 1. Pursuant to § 24-605 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, the Fire Department is designated the agency authorized to receive and file with the City Collector certificates of expenses for Fire Department costs incurred in responding to emergencies involving a release or substantial threat of a release of a hazardous substance into the environment. Such certificates shall be prepared in accordance with § 24-606 of the Administrative Code, shall set forth the work done and the expenses incurred, shall certify that such expenses were necessary and proper in the exercise of the Department's lawful powers and shall, where applicable, apportion such expenses among lots or buildings belonging to different persons. Pursuant to § 24-605, such costs shall constitute a lien against the real property at which such response measures were implemented.

Section 2. This Order shall take effect immediately.
