IN THE MATTER OF a Notice of Intent to acquire office space submitted by the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, pursuant to Section 195 of the New York City Charter for use of property located at 161-169 East 110th Street (Block 1638, Lots 28-31, 131) (Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, East Harlem Asthma Center), Community District 11, Borough of Manhattan.

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2008, the Department of Citywide Administrative Services (DCAS) submitted a Notice of Intent to acquire office space pursuant to Section 195 of the New York City Charter for the use of space located at 161-169 East 110th Street (Block 1638, Lots 28-31, 131), Community District 11, Borough of Manhattan, which is intended for use as offices by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene as the East Harlem Asthma Center; and

WHEREAS, this application (N 080351 PXM) was reviewed pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and the SEQRA regulations set forth in Volume 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations, Section 617.00 et seq. and the New York City Environmental Quality Review (CEQR) Rules of Procedure of 1991 and Executive Order 91 of 1977. This application was determined to be a Type II action which requires no further environmental review; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent was referred by the Department of City Planning to Manhattan Community Board 11 and to all Borough Presidents pursuant to Section 195 of the New York City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Borough President of Manhattan has not submitted a recommendation; and

WHEREAS, no recommendations were received from other Borough Presidents; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission held a public hearing on the application on April 9, 2007 (Calendar No. 13); and

WHEREAS, two representatives from the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and a representative from the Manhattan Borough President's Office appeared in favor; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was closed; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission, in reviewing the proposed location of office space has considered the following criteria of Article 7 of the Criteria for the Location of City Facilities as adopted by the City Planning Commission on December 3, 1990 pursuant to Section 203 (a) of the New York City Charter:

a) **Suitability of the site to provide cost-effective operations.** The space will be utilized by the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to establish the East Harlem Asthma Center. It will aim to reduce the burden of asthma in East Harlem by providing education, counseling and care coordination services. The proposed space at 161-169 East 110th Street will provide adequate space to meet the operational requirements and the space will comply with the provisions of the Americans With Disabilities Act

b) **Suitability of the site for operational efficiency.** 161-169 East 110th Street is located in a R7A/C2-5 zoning district, which permits the use. The site is centrally located within the area to be served. The 4, 5, and 6 subway lines are nearby as well as the M15, M101, M102, and M105 bus lines.

c) **Consistency with locational and other specific criteria for the facility stated in the Statement of Needs.** The facility was not listed in the Citywide Statement of Needs. However, the facility meets the criteria established for the siting, such as access to public transportation, ADA accessibility, and proximity to the area to be served.

d) **Whether the facility can be located so as to support development and revitalization of the city's regional business districts without constraining operational efficiency.** The proposed space is not located within the city's regional business district but is conveniently located to mass transit.

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that the application warrants approval and therefore adopts the following resolution:

RESOLVED, by the City Planning Commission that the Notice of Intent to acquire office space submitted by the Department of Citywide Administrative Services on March 26, 2008 for use of property located at 161-169 East 110th Street (Block 1638, Lots 28-31, 131). Community District 11, Borough of Manhattan, is hereby **APPROVED**.

The above resolution, duly adopted by the City Planning Commission on April 23, 2008 (Calendar No. 6), is filed with the Office of the Speaker, City Council in accordance with the requirements of Section 195 of the New York City Charter.
