  - The Department did not deny any application to renew a mobile food vending permit that was complete, timely submitted and where the mobile unit passes an inspection.
  - Five (5) permit-holders did not complete permit renewal applications, and the permits were, accordingly, not renewed.
- (iii) Number of food vendor license suspensions pursuant to section 17-317 of the Administrative Code and the basis for each such suspension:
  - No food vendor licenses were suspended during the reporting period.
- (iv) Number of food vending pushcart or vehicle permit suspensions pursuant to section 17-317 of the Administrative Code and the basis for each such suspension:
  - No food vending pushcart or vehicle permit renewals were suspended during the reporting period.
- (v) Number of food vendor license revocations pursuant to section 17-317 of the Administrative Code and the basis for each such revocation:
