An emergency lock in would not prevent access to the hotline unless access to phones had been restricted as a part of the emergency lock in measure. That said, emergency lock ins do not prevent medical services and anyone with a medical need can still access the clinic during an emergency lock in.

The number of lock-in extensions remained the same. The number of partial emergency lock-ins remained the same. The number of mandated services interrupted decreased. The number of continuous lock-in exceeding 24 hours increased.

⁴ Pursuant to local law 164, a continuous lock-in as used in this report refers to any period of time in which incarcerated individuals are confined to their cells or beds due to the combination of an emergency lock-in and either a scheduled lock-in or a lock-in extension, or both. For the purposes of this data metric, these 24-hour lock-in periods are continuous lock-ins, including both scheduled lock-ins and emergency-lock-in periods.
