

NYC Department of Health Bureau of Early Intervention FY2023 Annual Report

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NOTES

- This report is presented in accordance with the requirements set forth in section 17-199.12 of the administrative code of the city of New York.
- The report reflects data from the New York City Early Intervention (EI) Program for the period July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 (FY2023).
- The EI Program provides developmental services to children ages birth to three with developmental delays and disabilities.
- The EI Program does not provide medical services, nursing services, psychological services, or health services.
- This report includes all data required per section 17-199.12 of the New York City Administrative Code except the following items, which the New York Early Intervention System (NYEIS) does not capture:
 - Classification of children by housing status (e.g., homeless, residing in temporary housing)
 - Classification of homeless shelters, childcare providers, and nonprofit organizations as referral sources
 - IFSP Recommendations for sign language or cued language services
 - o Service authorization data for children who have transferred to another NY EI jurisdiction
- If a category contains between one and five children or allows another category to be narrowed to between one and five children, the number has been replaced with an asterisk. A category that contains zero children has been reported as zero, unless such reporting would violate any applicable provision of federal, state, or local law relating to personally identifiable information.

INTRODUCTION

The Early Intervention (EI) Program is a federal entitlement program created as Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act to provide services to children under three years old with developmental delays and disabilities. In New York City, the EI Program is administered by the NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Bureau of Early Intervention. EI services, which are provided through a network of agencies in contract with the NYS Department of Health, are available regardless of families' race, ethnicity, income, or immigration status, at no cost to them.

The Bureau of Early Intervention is committed to ensuring that all eligible children have access to EI services and addressing historical racial disparities. Disparities are greatest for Black children, who represent 21% of the birth to three years population in New York City but only 19% of children referred to EI. However, 19% is an improvement from 17% observed in 2019, reflecting the Bureau's concentrated efforts in this area. In recent years, the Bureau has strengthened its community outreach and developed partnerships with community organizations, collective impact groups, and other City agencies to address misconceptions and stigma about the EI Program. In 2021-2023, partnerships with pediatric primary care practices at hospital systems serving communities with low rates of referral focused on increasing referral at younger ages with higher rates of retention. The Bureau also continues its academic collaborations with CUNY and SUNY, encouraging dissemination of best practices and engagement of graduating students to work in the EI Program.

FY2023 Highlights

After referrals to the NYC EI Program decreased during the COVID-19 pandemic, they began rebounding in FY2021. And in FY2022, the Program received 34,639 referrals, up 9% from FY2021, despite a 4% decline in the total population of children under 3 years of age. Some of this increase represents referrals that, in the absence of COVID, would have been made in FY2021. As expected, the number of referrals in FY2023 then decreased slightly to 33,942.

The same pattern was seen for multidisciplinary evaluations. The number of multidisciplinary evaluations submitted increased from 24,313 in FY2021 to 27,375 in FY2022 and then decreased to 26,806 in FY2023. The number of children receiving services continued to increase from 30,393 in FY2021 to 31,341 in FY2022 to 33,938 in FY2023.

Teletherapy was introduced in the NYS EI Program during the COVID pandemic, and has become an established method of EI service delivery. However, since COVID, families' preference for in-person services has grown, while interventionists have continued to prefer teletherapy. The result is that services are delayed while families wait for in-person availability, increasing the average time from IFSP meeting to first service from 21.6 days in FY2022 to 22.8 days in FY2023. The proportion of children who received all services within 30 days of the IFSP meeting was 55% in FY2023, up from 52% in FY2022.

REFERRALS - REPORTING ITEM 1

Item 1. The number of referrals for initial evaluations in total and disaggregated by referral source

There were 33,942 referrals to the EI Program in FY2023, down from 34,639 in FY2022. This is largely due to referrals made in FY2022 that would normally have been made in FY2021 but were delayed due to Covid concerns. Child and family trends were consistent with previous years. Nearly two-thirds of referrals were boys, which is consistent with the prevalence of disability in the population. English was the dominant language for 67% of families referred. About half of the remaining referrals (17%) were from Spanish-speaking families. The majority of referrals were from EI providers: 54% as compared to 60% in FY2022, with the difference largely attributable to an increase in medical referrals. Hospitals and doctors combined accounted for 18% of referrals in FY2023, as opposed to 14% in FY2022. This increase is attributed to the EI Program's collaboration with pediatric ambulatory centers to streamline referrals from pediatric providers to the Program.

INITIAL EVALUATIONS – REPORTING ITEM 2

Item 2. The number of initial evaluations conducted, including the number of such evaluations that resulted in a determination that the child was eligible for the Early Intervention Program.

A Multidisciplinary Evaluation (MDE) is performed by a team of qualified professionals from different disciplines who assess the child's functioning in the five developmental domains: physical, cognitive, communication, social-emotional, and adaptive. The results of the MDE will be used to determine the child's eligibility for the EI Program, based on eligibility criteria established by New York State.

During FY2023, 26,806 MDEs were completed. More than half (60%) of the children evaluated were determined eligible for the program. Eligibility was higher among Black children (67%) than among White (60%), Latinx (59%) and Asian/Pacific Islander/Native American (55%) children. Slightly more boys than girls were determined eligible (62% vs 56%), and eligibility was highest among children whose dominant language was neither English nor Spanish.

IFSP MEETINGS – REPORTING ITEMS 3-4

Item 3. The number of IFSP meetings convened less than or equal to 45 calendar days from the date of referral.

Item 4. The number of IFSP meetings that were convened more than 45 calendar days from the date of referral.

The Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) is a written plan that identifies the EI services the child and family will receive. Federal law requires that the initial IFSP meeting (during which the IFSP is developed) must be convened within 45 calendar days of the date the child is referred to the EI Program.

During FY2023, there were 15,113 initial IFSP meetings, of which 86% occurred within 45 days of the date of referral, or at a later date due to family reasons, as defined by Federal regulations. IFSPs delayed beyond 45 days for reasons that were not family-driven occurred most often among Black children (18%), and least often among Asian children (11%) and children who speak Spanish (11%).

ACTIVE IFSP – REPORTING ITEM 5

Item 5. The total number of children who have an active IFSP (i) during the reporting period and (ii) as of June 30 of the reporting period.

A total of 33,398 children had an active IFSP in FY2023, of whom 18,839 were active on June 30, 2023. White and Latinx children each comprised approximately one-third of children with active IFSPs.

TIME TO FIRST SERVICE – REPORTING ITEM 6

Item 6. The average number of calendar days between the date of the initial IFSP meeting and the date children begin receiving Early Intervention services.

On average, children began receiving EI services within 22.8 days of their initial IFSP meeting. A significant contributor to this delay was families declining telehealth and choosing to wait for in-person services. Compared to white children, average time to service was six days longer for Black children, seven days longer for Latinx children and two days shorter for Asian/Pacific Islander/Native American children. The Bureau of Early Intervention has been advocating for differentials to be built into the State rate methodology to incentivize the delivery of in-person services, and of services provided in low-income communities, that would help address these delays.

AUTHORIZED SERVICES – REPORTING ITEM 7

Item 7. The number and percentage of children with IFSPs who, (i) during the reporting period and (ii) as of June 30 of the reporting period, have IFSPs that recommend certain authorized services.

All children with IFSPs received service coordination. In FY2023, the most frequently authorized services included speech-language pathology (86% of children), special instruction and applied behavior analysis (87%), occupational therapy (OT) (55%) and physical therapy (PT) (36%). Transportation services, provided to facilitate the child's receipt of center-based group developmental services, were the next most common service (9%), with each of the other enumerated services used by fewer than 5% of children. Percentages of children receiving each service type were consistent with FY2022.

- Higher percentages of white children received PT and lower percentages received speechlanguage pathology and special instruction compared to children of other races.
- Higher percentages of boys than girls received OT, special instruction, and speech-language pathology, and a lower percentage received PT.
- Higher percentages of children from English-dominant families received OT compared to children whose families speak other languages.
- Compared to children from English-dominant families, a lower percentage of children from Spanish-speaking families received PT, and higher percentages received special instruction and speech-language pathology.

TIMELINESS OF ALL SERVICES – REPORTING ITEM 8

Item 8. The number and percentage of children with IFSPs who were, during the reporting period, receiving in full the early intervention authorized services as recommended in their IFSPs within 30 days of the meeting; the number and percentage of children with IFSPs who were receiving in part such services within 30 days of such meeting and the number and percentage of children with IFSPs who were awaiting the provision of such services after 30 days of such meeting.

Almost all children (95%) start services within 30 days of their IFSP meeting, with 55% receiving their full package of services within that time frame. This is an increase from 52% in FY2022. This increase was present in all racial groups. Among Black children, 45% receive their full package of services within that time frame, an increase of 3% from FY2022. Higher percentages of girls (56% vs 54% for boys) and of children who speak languages other than English or Spanish (62% vs 53% for English- and 53% for Spanish-speaking children) received their full package of services within 30 days of IFSP. Reasons for children not receiving all services in 30 days include waits for in-person service availability; authorizations for team meetings for interventionists, which do not occur until the child has been receiving services for some time, large service packages with multiple services to be staffed, child illness, conflicting medical appointments, and family vacations.
