Pursuant to Section 3-05 of the Procurement Policy Board (PPB) rules, the New York City Administration for Children’s Services (ACS) intends

to enter a Sole Source contract with Rohde & Schwarz USA, Inc. for the purchase of Rohde & Schwarz QPS Body Scanners. The contract term is 11/1/2024 to 10/30/2027, and the funding amount is approximately \$1,500,000. ACS detains youth designated as Adolescent Offenders ages 16-20, who would otherwise have been held in the custody of the Department of Correction on Rikers Island. As part of its duties, ACS scans youth, visitors, and staff entering its Secure Detention facilities at the front and back entrances, in order to ensure safety.
