Campaign Finance

A candidate and his campaign committee were charged with violating the Campaign Finance Act during the candidate's unsuccessful campaign for re-election to the City Counsel. *Campaign Finance Board v. Gerson & Friends for Gerson*, OATH Index No. 2421/14 (Feb. 19, 2016).

CDRB dismisses claims as untimely filed.

On appeal a contractor sought \$12,570,174 in additional compensation for its subcontractor as a result of delays that lead to increased supervisory costs, relating to a contract with the Department of Design and Construction for the renovation of City Hall. 
