AMENDMENT OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 84 (Dated July 1, 1968)

Whereas, It is necessary and desirable to amend Executive Order No. 84, dated July 1, 1968, regarding the New York City Council Against Poverty.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Mayor of The City of New York, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, subsection d of Executive Order No. 84, dated July 1, 1968, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"d. Term. The term of office for members of the Council other than public officials shall be four years. Public officials may serve unlimited terms. All other members shall not hold office be not four consecutive years or a total of eight years."
