EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 166

AMENDMENT OF EMERGENCY EVACUATION AND RE-OCCUPATION AND
TRANSPORTATION ORDER

November 1, 2012

WHEREAS, Executive Order 163 declares a state of emergency in the City of New York; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 165 sets forth a prohibition on passenger vehicles containing fewer than three persons entering Manhattan via the East River bridges, with certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, taxicabs and for-hire vehicles licensed by the Taxi and Limousine Commission should be exempted from the prohibition,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered:

§ 1. Section 4 of Executive Order 165 is amended to read as follows:

§ 4. All passenger vehicles containing fewer than three persons (including the driver) are hereby prohibited from entering Manhattan via the Brooklyn Bridge, the Manhattan Bridge, the Ed Koch Queensboro Bridge, and the Williamsburg Bridge from 6 a.m. to midnight on Thursday, November 1, 2012 and Friday, November 2, 2012. The prohibition set forth immediately above shall not include: authorized emergency vehicles; buses; paratransit vehicles;

taxicabs; for-hire vehicles licensed by the Taxi and Limousine Commission; and commercial vehicles

§ 2. This Order shall take effect immediately.
