

Second—The returns of the year, arranged to show the number of deaths in each month, and also the proportion of males, females, adults, and children.

Third—A table showing the place of nativity of the deceased, with the sexes defined.

Fourth—A statement exhibiting the mortality in the several Public Institutions, as occurring in each month of the year, with Nativity, &c.

Fifth—A table of the deceased colored persons, with the monthly exhibit during the year.

Sixth—A comprehensive statement of the *External causes* of death, giving the numbers, sexes, nativities, and monthly divisions for the year.

Seventh—Tabular statements of the monthly mortality during the year, containing in detail the various causes, sexes, ages, nativities and colors.

Eighth—Annual recapitulation, showing the aggregate from every cause, with sexes, ages, nativities and colors.

Ninth—Annual recapitulation in monthly divisions of the numbers, with sexes, ages, nativities, and colors.

Tenth—Annual recapitulation by classification, relative to functional invasion, exhibiting the numbers, sexes, nativities, colors, public institutions, adults and children; with a summary, representing the various diseases, in classes and orders, both distinct and combined.

Eleventh—Recapitulation of the total monthly returns of deaths for the year, with sexes, ages, nativities and colors.

Twelfth—Table of the mortality in each ward during the year.

Thirteenth—Table of mortality in each public institution for the year, showing the numbers, sexes, nativities, and ages, with the reported *diseases* exhibited, printed on a large fold leaf.

Fourteenth—Table of the deceased male adults, with numbers, nativities, colors and *occupations*, as far as reported—showing that of 5,746 in this class, 3,773, or nearly two thirds have their business returned to this department for record; with a *Recapitulation*, diseases and occupations classified and condensed.

Fifteenth—Table of the births during the year, with the sexes and colors.

Sixteenth—Table of the marriages during the year, with the conditions, sexes, ages, and colors.

Seventeenth—Meteorological register for the year, with important additions.

Eighteenth—Remarks and comparative statement, forming a brief review of the present statistics.
