


Where Are Cultural Development Fund Awards Distributed Throughout New York City?

The Cultural Development Fund (CDF) is a competitive grant for nonprofit arts organizations administered by the Department of Cultural Affairs (DCLA). To understand how CDF awards are distributed across New York City, IBO analyzed award amounts by fiscal year and borough of the grantee organization's administrative address for fiscal years 2019 through 2023 (all years refer to fiscal years).

It is important to note that grantee organizations may provide programming outside of the borough where they are headquartered; this analysis does not show funding by where programs occurred. CDF grants were also automatically renewed during the pandemic. That means that 2019 and 2023 are the only competitive grant cycles represented below. Lastly, a small proportion of grantee organizations list addresses outside the five boroughs. Small nonprofits and those without physical footprints sometimes list home addresses as administrative addresses, and that may explain these grantees.

IBO matched grantee organizations to their administrative addresses using the most recently available Form 990 data from the IRS. Given the five-year scope of this analysis and the use of Form 990 data from as recently as 2022, some organizations may have changed boroughs between the time that they received a CDF grant and when they last submitted a Form 990. This could cause discrepancies if the data below were compared to data from grantees' original CDF applications.
