Dear Mr. McSweeney:

This Final Letter Report concerns the New York City Comptroller's audit of the New York City Office of the City Clerk & Clerk of the Council's (City Clerk's) compliance with Local Law 36, which governs waste prevention, reuse and recycling by New York City agencies. The objective of this audit was to determine whether the City Clerk is complying with the local law, which is intended to make City agencies, and ultimately the City as a whole, more sustainable through efforts that promote a clean environment, conserve natural resources and manage waste in a cost-effective manner. In addition, in the course of the audit, we noted efforts made by the City Clerk to follow recycling rules established by the New York City Department of Sanitation (DSNY) pursuant to Local Law 36. Our audit of the City Clerk is one in a series of audits we are conducting on the City's compliance with the local law.

Background

In 1989, New York City established Local Law 19, codified at Administrative Code §16-301, et seq., to establish an overarching "policy of the city to promote the recovery of materials from the New York City solid waste stream for the purpose of recycling such materials and returning them to the economy." The law mandates recycling in New York City by residents, agencies, institutions and businesses, and includes a series of rules to guide implementation. Local Law 19 requires the City to establish environmental policies to conserve natural resources and manage waste in a sustainable and cost-effective manner.

In 2010, the City enacted Local Law 36, which amended the recycling provisions of Local Law 19 (Administrative Code §16-307) to require each City agency to develop a Waste Prevention, Reuse and Recycling Plan and submit the plan to DSNY for approval by

July 1, 2011. Local Law 36 also requires each agency to designate a lead recycling or sustainability coordinator for the agency and, where the agency occupies more than one building, to designate an assistant coordinator for each building. By July 1, 2012, and in each year thereafter, the lead recycling coordinator for each agency is required to submit a report to the agency head and to DSNY "summarizing actions taken to implement the waste prevention, reuse, and recycling plan for the previous twelve-month reporting period, proposed actions to be taken to implement such plan, and updates or changes to any information included in such plan."

In addition, Local Law 36 requires the DSNY Commissioner to adopt, amend and implement regulations governing recycling by City mayoral and non-mayoral agencies. DSNY is also responsible for consolidating the information contained in agency reports and including this information in the agency's annual recycling report.

Findings and Recommendations

Our audit found that the City Clerk did not fully comply with Local Law 36. The City Clerk, as required by the law, has designated a lead recycling coordinator for its Manhattan office and additional assistant coordinators for offices in each of the other four boroughs. The City Clerk also source separates its recyclable materials. But we found that it did not establish a Waste Prevention, Reuse, and Recycling Plan for its agency, nor did it submit an annual report for Fiscal Years 2012 through 2016 to its agency head or to DSNY, as required by Local Law 36. Our findings are outlined in the table entitled Compliance Summary below.

In addition to these findings, however, we note that the City Clerk has made efforts to address waste prevention, reuse, and safe handling of hazardous waste beyond the requirements of the local law. Specifically, the City Clerk has set its printers to duplex printing as a default to reduce paper usage. The City Clerk also participates in a citywide contract for the removal of its electronic waste and follows the City's policy and procedures for the disposal of its surplus items. Those measures have been taken in accordance with DSNY's rules enacted pursuant to Local Law 36. During the audit the City Clerk provided us with documents to illustrate its efforts (see Exhibits A, B, C, and D).

We recommend that the City Clerk establish a Waste Prevention, Reuse, and Recycling Plan for its agency, and submit the required annual report to its agency head and DSNY by July 1st of each year as required by Local Law 36.

Scope and Methodology

We conducted this performance audit in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain sufficient, appropriate evidence to provide a reasonable basis for our findings and conclusions based on our audit objectives. We believe that the evidence obtained provides a reasonable basis for our findings and conclusions based on our audit objectives. This audit was conducted in accordance with the audit responsibilities of the City Comptroller as set forth in Chapter 5, §93, of the New York City Charter.

The scope period for this audit was July 1, 2011, the date Local Law 36 went into effect, through April 28, 2017, the last day of our fieldwork. Our methodology for this audit consisted of the following steps:

- We reviewed applicable laws, rules, policies and procedures to determine our criteria in accordance with Local Law 36, including Local Law 19, DSNY's agency Waste Prevention, Reuse, and Recycling Plan template and DSNY's recycling reporting requirements for City agencies;
- We sent an electronic survey to the City Clerk to determine whether the agency met the key provisions of Local Law 36, reflected as the core criteria in the table below, and analyzed the survey results and other additional materials provided by the City Clerk;
- We requested the City Clerk's Waste Prevention, Reuse, and Recycling Plan, list of coordinators, and the agency's annual reports for 2012 through 2016; and
- We conducted interviews with the City Clerk's recycling/sustainability coordinator to discuss the agency's recycling and waste prevention efforts and visited the City Clerk's facility to verify its compliance with Local Law 36.

Based on our understanding of the Local Law 36 requirements, we outlined all the criteria necessary for agencies to be in compliance. The table below outlines agencies' core criteria required to achieve compliance under Local Law 36. A summary of these core criteria forms the basis for the compliance summary reported for each audited agency.

Because many agencies may have pursued initiatives beyond these core requirements, we recognized agencies' additional actions regarding recycling and sustainability. Our observations are based on the additional actions established by DSNY in its Waste Prevention, Reuse, and Recycling Plan implementation guidelines and other efforts taken by agencies.

The issues covered in this report were discussed with the City Clerk officials during and at the conclusion of this audit, and City Clerk officials agreed no exit conference was necessary. On May 9, 2017, we submitted a draft report providing the City Clerk with the opportunity to formally respond. The City Clerk's response was received on May 23, 2017. In its written response, the City Clerk agreed with the report's findings and stated that "[t]he City Clerk will establish a plan by the close of Fiscal Year [2017]" and "shall submit an annual report to its agency head and to DSNY by July 1 as required by Local Law 36." The City Clerk also resubmitted documentation (Exhibits A, B, C, and D) in its written response. Those documents were part of our examination into the agency's compliance with Local Law 36. We recognized those efforts that were taken by the City Clerk beyond the core requirements of Local Law 36 and have already acknowledged them as the agency's additional actions.

The full text of the City Clerk's comments is included as an addendum to this report.

Dear Deputy Comptroller Landa:

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to your May 9, 2017 draft Letter Report on the Office of the City Clerk & Clerk of the Council's ("City Clerk's") Compliance with Local Law 36 which governs waste prevention, reuse and recycling by City Agencies. We acknowledge the findings and recommendations of the Comptroller with respect to areas of compliance and recommendations regarding areas of non-compliance. The specific findings are addressed in further detail below. In addition, we appreciate the Comptroller's acknowledgement that the City Clerk has made efforts to address waste prevention, reuse, and safe handling of hazardous waste beyond the requirements of the local law.

Comptroller's Findings:

The City Clerk recycles designated materials pursuant to Local Law 36 criteria.

City Clerk Response:

The City Clerk works closely with DCAS maintenance personnel to assist in proper recycling and disposition of waste. Labeled recycling containers are currently available in all public areas and separated into three separate streams: (1) mixed paper and cardboard, (2) metal, glass, plastic and cartons, and (3) garbage. Whenever possible, the Office of the City Clerk utilizes waste prevention, green purchasing, and reuse practices. Paper recycling bins are placed next to all bulk copiers and printers. A large majority of paper waste is shredded and recycled accordingly by DCAS personnel. We readily provide scanners for members of the executive staff and the Lobbying Bureau of the City Clerk and encourage the electronic distribution of documents whenever possible. For instance, the Lobbying Bureau is responsible for the enforcement of the City's lobbying law and the regulation of approximately 2,000 lobbyists and

4,000 lobbying clients. Since 2006, all filings which were previously completed on paper have been filed electronically and, to the extent practicable, all bulk correspondence is distributed electronically. In addition, to cut down on paper use, the Lobbying Bureau utilizes an electronic content management system called "Open KM".

Comptroller's Findings:

The City Clerk has designated a lead recycling coordinator for its Manhattan Office and additional assistant coordinators for offices in each of the other four boroughs.

City Clerk Response:

Damaris Acosta, Deputy City Clerk, currently serves as the agency's Lead Recycling and Sustainability Coordinator. The City Clerk has designated an assistant coordinator for each office as follows: Bronx – Shirley Saunders; Brooklyn – Edison Stewart; Queens – Helen Sears; and Staten Island – Robin Aryakia.

Comptroller's Findings:

The City Clerk did not establish a Waste, Prevention, Reuse, and Recycling Plan as required by Local Law 36.

City Clerk Response:

Although the City Clerk has not formally adopted a waste prevention, reuse and recycling plan, we currently have several policies and procedures in place that comply with the goals and directives of Local Law 36 of 2010. The City Clerk will establish a plan by the close of Fiscal Year 2016.

Comptroller's Findings:

The City Clerk did not submit an annual report for Fiscal Years 2012 to 2016 to its agency head and to DSNY as required by Local Law 36.

City Clerk Response:

The City Clerk shall submit an annual report to its agency head and to DSNY by July 1 as required by Local Law 36.

Although the Office of the City Clerk has not fully complied with Local Law 36, we have made several efforts to address waste prevention, reuse, and the safe handling of hazardous waste in furtherance of the goals and directives of Local Law 36 of 2010. Whenever possible, the Office of the City Clerk purchases green products. The majority of our products are certified as non-toxic. For example, at the launch of our official "Right to Know" training program, we commenced utilizing lubricant sheets for shredders rather than shredder oil which is designated a toxic product. See Exhibit A. In addition, our office follows the environmentally safe disposal procedures mandated by COSH, PESH and OSHA. See Exhibit B.

In order to reduce paper use, our office utilizes multipurpose recycled paper. In addition, all of our printers are set to default duplex printing and we encourage staff to copy all documents double sided whenever possible. We encourage the reuse of all office products and always re-use rather than purchase new items. For instance, we collect all unused office supplies and stock them in our supply closet for distribution and re-use.

The Office of the City Clerk follows the Department of Sanitation's contract to remove and dispose of agency generated electronic, lighting, mercury and sharp waste. See <u>Exhibit D</u>. With respect to obsolete office furniture, we follow DCAS's Office of Surplus Activities policies and procedures. See <u>Exhibit C</u>.

Thank you very much for your professionalism and attention during this audit. We appreciate the information that you have provided and will make best efforts to remain in full compliance with Local Law 36. Please feel free to contact my office if you have any further questions or require additional information.



Sorry for the delay in getting this to you. As we discussed, you can request disposal authorization for your agency's surplus items in accordance with the attached OSA Policy & Procedures. In this document, you will find specific template wording that can be copied and paste to auctions (electronic relinquishments) for items needing scrap or destroy authorization. In section 3, Destroy Determination, you will find the process and template wording for metal content item disposal. You will also find the DSNY Operations contact number to arrange for bulk metal disposal.

Please see the below DSNY link for guidance on what should be considered electronic equipment. This can be a bit of a grey area and as you can see from the list, time clocks (I believe you were referring to the type that punch a date/time on documents) and shredders are not listed. As electronic equipment is generally defined as any item having a circuit board and operating by electricity, I would say time clocks and shredders are not to be considered electronic equipment. Such items fall more into the category of appliance/mechanical devices. I have conferred with DSNY and they are in agreement.

Section 3.0

ELECTRONIC-WASTE RELINQUISHMENT - Electronic Waste (E-Waste) is any electronic device, or their associated parts. Computers, printers, televisions, VCRs, stereos, copiers, and fax machines are common electronic products. Many of these products can be reused, refurbished, or recycled. However, many components of these products are toxic and not biodegradable.

In 2010, the New York Department of Sanitation (DSNY) awarded an Agency Safe Handling Contract (ASHC). As a result of the implementation of this "Contract to Remove, Handle, and Process Agency-Generated Electronic, Lighting and Mercury Waste, and Sharp Waste," OSA no longer accepts relinquishment for materials/items covered under ASHC (i.e., E-Waste having no reuse or resale value).

Note: CPUs having their hard drive removed but all other integral components intact may be considered functioning items and therefore having a reuse or resale value.



ASHC is accessible to Mayoral agencies based on the EPA Regulatory Law that stipulates Mayoral agencies only; Non-Mayoral agencies do not have access to ASHC and therefore must handle their E-Waste disposal needs via 3rd party vendors knowledgeable in the recycling/disposal of such material. For information on the contract, please go to: http://cityshare.nycnet/ashcontract

Your agency Information Technology Officer shall make a "hazardous waste determination" for all items covered under the DSNY Contract. Items determined by this officer as having reuse and/or resale value must be relinquished to DCAS/OSA in accordance with the "Relinquishment Process" explained in Section 1 above. Depending on each agency's hazardous waste determination, items not requiring relinquishment should include:

Universal Waste

- Mercury-containing lamps, including all fluorescent lamps, high intensity discharge (HD), neon, mercury vapor, high pressure sodium, and metal handle lamps;
- Mercury containing equipment such as thermostats, or blood pressure cuffs;
- Batteries (excluding alkaline batteries which are to be disposed of as trash);
- Used electronic equipment such as televisions, computers and associated hardware, fax machines, printers, etc.

Hazardous Waste

- Broken mercury-containing lamps, including all fluorescent lamps, high intensity discharge (HD), neon, mercury vapor, high pressure sodium, and metal handle lamps.
- Broken and obsolete electronic equipment such as televisions, computers and associated hardware, fax machines, printers, etc. (CRT and LCD monitors smaller than

17" and CPU models older than Core 2 Duo/Core Dual are considered to be obsolete.)

NOTE: Electronic-Waste determination as to whether or not items have utilization or revenue value must be accurate to avoid unnecessary relinquishment processing and cancellations.

- Mayoral Agencies Generally, electronic items (as defined above) no longer needed by a Mayoral Agency, are to be disposed of via ASHC. Exceptions are:
 - a. Unique electronic items or electronic items deemed by the agency IT Officer to have reuse and/or resale value; these may be submitted to DCAS/OSA in accordance with the "Relinquishment Process" explained in Section 1 above.
 - b. In the event that no transfer or sale is accomplished for such items, OSA will place the following statement in the "Notes" section: "E-Waste Disposal - Items received no internal claim interest or bids and are therefore deemed to have no reuse and/or resale value. In accordance with E-Waste policy and procedures, your agency is to dispose of the subject items via the ASHC."
 - c. The "Notes" field update will be received by the agency salvage officer (i.e., PSG automatically generates the notice). At this point, the agency has authorization to dispose of the subject items.

Electronic items deemed by an agency's IT Officer to have no reuse and/or sale value must be disposed of via ASHC; OSA will not accept them. If an agency submits an Electronic-Waste Item(s) that it deems to have no reuse or sale value, OSA will release and immediately retract the subject online auction updating the "Notes" field with the following statement: "E-Waste Disposal - Items deemed to have no reuse and/or sale value. In accordance with E-Waste policy and procedures, your agency is to dispose of the subject items via the ASHC."

2. **Non-Mayoral Agencies** - The same policy and procedures as detailed above for Mayoral agencies shall apply to electronic item disposal for Non-Mayoral agencies with the exception that Non-Mayoral agencies do not have access to the ASHC and must dispose of such items via 3rd party vendors knowledgeable in the recycling/disposal of E-Waste and all relevant Federal, State, and Local environmental laws for such materials. DSNY provides a list of such vendors at the following website:

3. Exceptions

- a. Unique electronic items or electronic items deemed by the agency IT Officer to have reuse and/or resale value; these may be submitted to DCAS/OSA in accordance with the "Relinquishment Process" explained in Section 1 above.

In the event that no transfer or sale is accomplished for such items, OSA will place the following statement in the "Notes" section: "E-Waste Disposal - Items received no internal claim interest or bids and are therefore deemed to have no reuse and/or resale value. In accordance with E-Waste policy and procedures, your agency is to dispose of the subject items via a 3rd party vendor knowledgeable in the recycling/disposal of such items."
- c. The "Notes" field update will be received by the agency salvage officer (i.e., PSG automatically generates the notice). At this point, the agency has authorization to dispose of the subject items.


