Gas Piping Inspection Deadline Extended



Hey NYC, did you know the deadlines for mandatory gas piping inspections have been extended for certain Community Districts in all five boroughs?

Building owners in Community Districts 2, 5, 7, 13 and 18 in their borough, will now have until **June 30, 2022**, to complete their mandatory Local Law 152 of 2016 gas plumbing inspections, which must be conducted at least once every four years. One- and two-family homes are exempt from Local Law 152

Zoning For Accessibility



As of October 7, 2021, all development and enlargement projects in New York City that are within 50 feet of a mass transit station, must comply with updated Zoning Resolution requirements and obtain approval from the Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA) prior to filing an application with the Department of Buildings.

The change is part of the city's Zoning for Accessibility program, which seeks to make our transit system more accessible.
