WEEKLY INCIDENT BRIEF - COVID-19 08/17/2020 – 08/24/20

Incident Summary

NYC Emergency Management continues to coordinate with our partners at the City, State, and Federal levels as well as the private sector in response to COVID-19. As of August 17, 2020, there are 231,401 COVID-19 positive cases in New York City. Additionally:

- Per <u>CDC guidance</u>, employers should not require a positive COVID-19 test result or a healthcare provider's note for employees who are sick to validate their illness, qualify for sick leave, or to return to work.
- Governor Cuomo <u>released a guide</u> to the state's "NY Forward Reopening" Plan.
- Information about reopening and Phase 4 guidance New York City can be found here.
- Governor Cuomo announced the implementation of a new <u>early warning dashboard</u> to monitor and review how the virus is being contained on an ongoing basis.

There are no specific vaccines or treatments available for this novel coronavirus, or any other coronavirus. However, medication and vaccine research continues.
