Do you know the difference between Veteran's Day and Memorial Day?

Understanding the nuances between Veteran's Day and Memorial Day is imperative. Veteran's Day, observed annually on November 11th, serves as a tribute to the dedication of all Armed Forces Veterans. Conversely, Memorial Day, occurring on the last Monday of May each year, holds a more somber significance as a day of reflection for those who made the ultimate sacrifice as United States Armed Forces Soldiers. It is a poignant occasion dedicated to honoring the memory of fallen soldiers and offering solace to their bereaved families.

Originally named Decoration Day, Memorial Day tradition entails visiting, cleaning, and adorning graves to commemorate the valor of the men and women who perished in defense of our freedoms. The symbolic gesture of the American flag further underscores the solemnity of the occasion. Raised swiftly to full-staff at dawn, it is then solemnly lowered to half-staff until noon, signifying mourning, before being hoisted to full-staff again until sunset, symbolizing the enduring memory of the fallen.

While Memorial Day marks the unofficial onset of summer, heralding beach openings and the commencement of grilling season, it also registers as a peak period for travel. Whether partaking in leisurely activities, such as watching the NASCAR Cup Series race or capitalizing on holiday sales, or journeying to reunite with loved ones, it is paramount to uphold situational awareness. Prioritizing safety remains paramount, particularly for CERT members, during this extended weekend of remembrance and recreation.

NYC CERT at Pix Church Avenue Fair







Queens Division 4 Monthly Team Meeting




On May 20, 2024, Bronx Division 1 shared lessons learned from Disasterville exercise while discussing support for new members interested in Radio trainings.

THINGS TO KNOW

How To Request NYC CERT

If approached to support an event in your community, the following steps must be taken:



- Event organizer submits an official request using the NYC CERT External Request Form.
- NYC CERT Leadership should not submit form on behalf of the event organizer.
- For events lead by a NYC CERT Division, volunteer leadership (Ready New York Liaison, if a preparedness event) should submit this Event Request form

NYC CERT program staff will review all requests. If approved, program staff will add the volunteer opportunity to the NYC CERT Event Calendar with a registration link. If more details are required for approval, program staff will use the contact information provided in the request form to connect with the organizer.


